3. News from the committees

3.1. <u>University Assembly</u>

- first, the president and chancellor introduced themselves again
- Chancellor was re-elected by the assembly, but not the president
- A finding committee is now being formed for the position of President to look for a replacement
- It was inquired why the Chancellor was decided in this way regarding the lecturer who did not have a valid 3G proof (see item 4 in the protocol)

3.2. Faculty Council

- 29.06.2022 "Tag der Ingenieurwissenschaft" (Engineering Science Day) in Weimar
- Soon central system for contact tracking enabled
- Successor for the professorship of "Baubetrieb" (construction operations) has been found and will start on 01.04.2022
- Appointment procedure math and geotechnics still under negotiation
- Moving graduation ceremony to summer (summaery)?
 - o State of opinion FsR: connection with visa?; in summer nicer ambience

3.3. University and Student Advisory Council of the City of Weimar (HSB)

- Dr.in Lorenz (new president of the Klassik Stiftung) has introduced herself.
 - Meadow at the Palace in the Ilmpark has now been approved by the monument preservation authorities for resting. "KiWi" and meadow at the bee museum are to follow
 - o In addition, more trash cans are to be placed in the park
 - Parts of the Ilm river bank are to be made accessible and usable (talks with monument protection are underway)
 - Talks about culture ticket (free of charge as in Jena; test run with free DNT ticket; Studierendenwerk wants to support)

- Studierendenwerk: Mensa should in theory be finished this year, but there are delivery bottlenecks for kitchen parts, so it will probably be January 2022.
- Wielandplatz was redesigned in 2013/2014 to revitalize it; however, due to the not expected revitalization, many residents are disturbed; after escalation in 2016, the then-mayor demanded stronger police controls so that the square becomes unattractive again; working group was founded and tries to develop concepts (however, without representation from the student body); Corona has aggravated the problem again, followed by a ban on glass bottles and alcohol (should apply annually until 2026 from March to October); HSB wants to submit proposals for action to this working group; however, HSB only acts in an advisory capacity for the city and voices should better come directly from the student body
- Lisa is currently only a substitute member, so a primary member still needs to be found for the remaining term of 1.5 years

3.4. Extended Faculty Management

3.5. StuKo

- Bilinguality in committees was discussed; the majority of committee members do not want to hold meetings in English.
- StuKo budget meetings are finished; it was decided that Fsr B will receive only one instead of two euros per student

4. News from the study programs

- Last week the 3G control team controlled the lecture Statik I of Prof. Könke.
 - Almost all participants were controlled, so was Mr. Könke; however, he could not show a valid 3G proof - only a photo of a negative self-test with current date, which is not considered as an approved proof
 - However, after being asked to break up the lecture, he refused. The control team then went to the chancellor, who dismissed it as a "one-time occurrence"
 - A few days later Mr. Könke sent a mail in which he stated that it is no longer possible for him to offer his lecture under these conditions and will upload the scripts in moodle as well as be available for consultations
 - Today (5pm) a new mail came with a survey if the consultations should continue like this or if the students would like to have a live online lecture (which is forbidden to be held via zoom)
 - In the crisis team on Monday it was decided that instructors who do not offer a face-to-face course must offer their course online
 - Questionable "P. S." messages are also repeatedly attached in his mails to students
 - Students from the course want consequences for this behavior; these mails should be shown to faculty management

- Other professors in the department also behave similarly (no mask is worn when checking, the orange seats are ignored, the lecture is started although checks are still in progress) → pass this on again to Conrad Völker
- Corona denying flyers found in lecture hall building
 - Should best be passed on to dean
 - o It is not known by whom these leaflets were distributed
